Pray for Our West-Ark Mission Points



AGAPE ASIA: We will be funding a ministry in Laos to provide needed care to young men, who would otherwise be abandoned and vulnerable to all kinds of evils. They will live in a Christian home, be able to go to school, and will learn trade skills, all while hearing they have a Good Father in Heaven Who loves and cares for them.



BULGARIA: Christo Arnaudov and his wife, Vania, serve the Renaissance Church of Christ in Sofia, Bulgaria. Since the '90s, they have worked to present "the forbidden book" (the Bible) to all Bulgarians. Our financial support allows them to continue their ministry and assists congregation assemblies. Jeana Belote lived in Sofia for several years to assist the establishment of children's ministry.





ETHIOPIA: The Lord's work in Ethiopia continues to grow. Due to warring factions, the challenges are great and there are areas that are unsafe for travel because of attacks on vehicles and kidnappings. Faithful rural churches continue to serve and grow. Because many are moving to urban areas, the Addis Ababa Bible Training Institute, directed by Jim Wilson, provides a two-year program to train twenty young men with practical experiences emphasizing urban evangelism.



ESWATINI (SWAZILAND): Dr. Bob and Annette Whitaker established the Mathangeni Church of Christ Clinic in Matsapha. The outpatient clinic serves a densely populated factory area. The Whitakers teach individual and group Bible studies, and Bob serves as an elder of the Mathangeni congregation.





GUYANA: Our yearly medical mission trips to Guyana between 1991 and 2010 led to West-Ark funding the training of Narine Khublall in 1995-97. We continue to provide partial funding for his successful evangelistic work. His preaching and teaching have resulted in many baptisms and the establishment of three congregations in Guyana. We fund the training of Hugo Simon at Georgetown School of Preaching and Biblical Studies.





HONDURAS: In Tegucigalpa, John and Michael Carson serve with Breaking Chains to invest in relationships that act as a gateway to a relationship with Christ. They provide a home for ten young adults and food relief to those on the street and to their church family members. Their education program helps thirty students attend private school and prepare for a brighter future.





INDIA: Jayakar Benjamin became acquainted West-Ark through our online worship. With our assistance, the Narasaraopet Church of Christ serves a meal after worship services, which has successfully brought many souls to their worship assembly.





LAOS: We provide funds for Bible and vocational training of future Lao leaders at the Bangkok Servant Leaders Institute; translation of Thai and English Bible study materials into Lao; expense monies for Lao evangelists to assist rural congregations in the north and south of Laos, and regional meetings of Christians for Bible study and encouragement. Our efforts are assisted by the weekly contributions of the Lao Church of Christ meeting at West-Ark.



MOZAMBIQUE: After hearing the call to serve the Makua people, Brooklyn Howard moved to the East African country to start an English program. She spends her days sharing the gospel through teaching English, visiting and encouraging the newly formed churches in the area, attending Bible studies, and has built a house! Please pray for the hearts of her students and the Church in Northern Mozambique.





SE Asia: Since 2012, our missionaries have worked with Bible translation and literacy for an underserved people/language group. The translation of Mark's gospel has been completed, and they are currently working on Luke. Their vision of service is enhanced knowledge of Scripture and resulting establishment of congregations of the Church.





NIGERIA: We assist Christians in Nigeria in their evangelism and rural congregation growth in six Nigeria states. Our efforts focus on support for Bible training schools, weekly World Radio programs, and multiple regional seminars for Bible training, edification, and encouragement. We provide partial funds for rural assembly buildings, and respond to many housing and medical problems.





THAILAND: In partnership with the Pleasant Valley Church of Christ, we provide salary and work fund assistance to Thai evangelists working in leadership training of Thai and Lao students in Bangkok, university student outreach in Bangkok, and Bible materials/assembly support to multiple rural congregations of the Church in Thailand and Laos.





UNITED STATES: We assist the Wolfe and Sigmon families who serve in the Ohio University Encompass Campus Ministry in Athens, Ohio. Students have prayed for the first time, created a deeper understanding of who God is, reconciled their relationship with God, and have accepted the call to make disciples.





VIETNAM: WestArk continues to assist the evangelistic outreach in Ho Chi Minh City by providing assembly assistance for the Saigon Church of Christ and scholarships to assist young and teen aged students with public school expenses. We provide financial assistance to the family of Stephane Phoumasone.
