The Mind of Christ

We continue our sermon series on the book of Philippians. Our worship this week will be based on Phil. 2:1-11. Contained in this section is the rather lyrical section known as "the Christ Hymn." It begins in verse 6. Some scholars believe that this may be one of the earliest Christian hymns sung by the church of the first century. If that's the case, then Paul is using a well-known hymn to illustrate a point about the Mind of Christ.

We begin in the heavenly realm with Christ who is on equal footing with God. But he emptied himself of all privilege; he humbled himself and became a servant. That obedience leads to his death on the cross. It is a low, low point for one who was equal with God. Death is not the end. Because of his obedience and faithfulness, God exalts him and gives him authority over all things. This is why we will all bow down and confess that Jesus Christ is Lord. Let's all continue to learn and grow together - all to HIS glory!
